24 DAY ITINERARY

Day 1 - Wednesday 29 August AUCKLAND - VANCOUVER

This evening meet at Auckland Airport for the start of our journey. We arrive in Vancouver in the afternoon.

Day 2 - Thursday 30 August VANCOUVER

Enjoy today at leisure. (B)

Day 3 - Friday 31 August VANCOUVER

At 6pm, meet your Tour Director and travelling companions for a welcome drink. (B)

Day 4 - Saturday 01 September VANCOUVER - VICTORIA

Tour Vancouver, including the waterfront, Chinatown, and Stanley Park. Catch the FERRY to Vancouver Island and Victoria. Visit world famous BUTCHART GARDENS, followed by a special dinner in the original Butchart family residence. See major attractions on your orientation tour through Victoria, including the Fairmont Empress Hotel, Bastion Square, and Thunderbird Park. (B, D)

Day 5 - Sunday 02 September VICTORIA

This day is free to explore on your own. (B)

Day 6 - Monday 03 September VICTORIA - WHISTLER

Board a BC FERRY and cross the Strait of Georgia through the Gulf Islands. Stop at SHANNON FALLS, where a boardwalk leads to a viewing platform near the base of the roaring falls. On to the alpine resort of Whistler. (B)

Day 7 - Tuesday 04 September WHISTLER

Today is free to explore all that Whistler has to offer. (B)

Day 8 - Wednesday 05 September WHISTLER - SUN PEAKS

This morning, enjoy a visit and private breakfast at the SQUAMISH LIL'WAT CULTURAL CENTRE, dedicated to the history and culture of the First Nations people. Then, journey through the Cariboo region. Afternoon arrival in Sun Peaks, with the balance of the day at leisure. (B)

Day 9 - Thursday 06 September SUN PEAKS - JASPER

Continue north into the province of Alberta. See the base of the 3954 metre Mount Robson (the highest point in the Canadian Rockies) before entering JASPER NATIONAL PARK. (B, D)

Day 10 - Friday 07 September JASPER: EXCURSION TO MALIGNE LAKE

Enjoy a short sightseeing tour to see Jasper's unspoiled beauty. Then travel to glacial Maligne Lake for a narrated CRUISE to Spirit Island. On the return

journey, stop to view Maligne Canyon. Balance of the day is at leisure. (B)

Day 11 - Saturday 08 September JASPER - COLUMBIA ICEFIELD - LAKE LOUISE - BANFF

This morning, travel through Jasper National Park on Icefields Parkway to the 365-metre-thick Columbia Icefield for a thrilling ICE EXPLORER RIDE. Climb Sunwapta Pass to savour stunning vistas then scale Bow Pass for views of Peyto Lake. Next, stop at Lake Louise. Continue into BANFF NATIONAL PARK. (B)

Day 12 - Sunday 09 September BANFF

Breakfast this morning is served on top of Sulphur Mountain. Take a ride on the BANFF GONDOLA to the top of the mountain and enjoy spectacular views of the valley below as you savour a flavourful meal. Additional sightseeing in Banff includes a visit to Bow Falls and the Hoodoos. The balance of the day is at leisure. (B, D)

Day 13 - Monday 10 September BANFF - YOHO NATIONAL PARK - GLACIER NATIONAL PARK - BRITISH COLUMBIA WINE COUNTRY

Depart Banff and scale Kicking Horse Pass into British Columbia and Yoho National Park. Next, enjoy vistas of peaks exceeding 3,048 metres on Rogers Pass at the summit in Canada's Glacier National Park. Descend into the Okanagan Valley to Kelowna. A special evening is in store for you with a tour and dinner at SUMMERHILL PYRAMID WINERY. (B, D)

Day 14 - Tuesday 11 September BRITISH COLUMBIA WINE COUNTRY - VANCOUVER

Travel over the Cascade Mountains into Vancouver. Upon arrival, enjoy some time at leisure. This evening, your Tour Director hosts a farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day 15 - Wednesday 12 September VANCOUVER (CRUISE EMBARKATION)

Embark Holland America's MS Volendam. (B, D)

Day 16 - Thursday 13 September SCENIC CRUISING: INSIDE PASSAGE

Sit back and relax as you cruise through the beautiful and awe-inspiring scenery of the Inside Passage. (B,L,D)

Day 17 - Friday 14 September TRACY ARM & JUNEAU

This narrow, 42-kilometre-long fjord is another of Alaska's most dramatic glacier settings. The panorama of 2,134-metre mountain peaks and nearly vertical rock cliffs is astounding. Waterfalls appear at every turn. And tucked away at the end of this remarkable waterway are two very

active reminders of the Ice Age-the twin Sawyer Glaciers, which calve icebergs into the jade-coloured inland sea. Visit one of the most remote capital cities-Juneau. Accessible only by air and water, Juneau is located at the base of two mountains in the heart of Alaska's Inside Passage. (B,L,D)

Day 18 - Saturday 15 September SKAGWAY

Once a major port for gold prospectors who passed through en route to the Yukon, today you can still ride the antique White Pass & Yukon Route narrow-gauge railway up past Deadhorse Gulch to see what it was like ages ago. (B,L,D)

Day 19 - Sunday 16 September SCENIC CRUISING: GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK

This Biosphere Reserve and UNESCO World Heritage Site protects a unique ecosystem in an ever-changing glacial landscape. National Park rangers accompany the ship, adding expert commentary to the day's events. (B,L,D)

Day 20 - Monday 17 September KETCHIKAN

Experience Native Alaska firsthand. Meet the spirits of the raven, whale, and eagle as you view the largest collection of totems in the world at Saxman Totem Park or Totem Bight State Historic Park. (B,L,D)

Day 21 - Tuesday 18 September SCENIC CRUISING: INSIDE PASSAGE

Take a second spin through Alaska's Inside Passage. (B,L,D)

Day 22 - Wednesday 19 September VANCOUVER

After disembarking from your cruise ship, we travel to Vancouver's North Shore for a trip to CAPILANO BRIDGE and GROUSE MOUNTAIN, before transferring to the airport in the late afternoon for your journey home. (B)

Day 23 - Thursday 20 September VANCOUVER - AUCKLAND

In transit.

Day 24 - Friday 21 September AUCKLAND
