# 25 DAY ITINERARY

## Day 1 – Wednesday 22 August AUCKLAND – HONG KONG

This afternoon meet at Auckland Airport for the start of our journey. We arrive in Hong Kong in the evening.

## Day 2 – Thursday 23 August HONG KONG

## Day 3 – Friday 24 August HONG KONG – ROME, ITALY

Arrive in Rome early this morning and transfer to your hotel, which has been pre-booked for early check in. The rest of the day is free for you to explore. In the afternoon, meet your Tour Director and fellow travellers.

## Day 4 – Saturday 25 August ROME

Included sightseeing with a Local Guide starts with St. Peter's Square and Basilica. Other highlights are the Colosseum; the Roman Forum; Piazza Venezia, and Campidoglio. An optional visit is available to the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel. (B)

## Day 5 – Sunday 26 August ROME – PISA - FLORENCE

Vistas of rolling hills, cypress trees, vineyards, olive groves, and rural villages form the backdrop of your journey through Tuscany. Take a break in Pisa to see the SQUARE OF MIRACLES and the amazing Leaning Tower. (B, D)

## Day 6 – Monday 27 August FLORENCE – VENICE AREA

On the included walking tour with a Local Guide, discover the landmarks of Florence, like Piazza Signoria, Palazzo Vecchio, and the cathedral on Piazza del Duomo. Later, watch how leather is embossed with gold, and enjoy free time. (B)

## Day 7 – Tuesday 28 August VENICE AREA

Venice is known worldwide for its carnival, film festival, and incredible location on the water. Today, reach Venice by private MOTORBOAT to view the Bridge of Sighs, Doges' Palace, and St. Mark's Square before a visit to a GLASSBLOWING WORKSHOP. (B, D)

## Day 8 – Wednesday 29 August VENICE AREA – CORTINA – INNSBRUCK AREA, AUSTRIA

Drive northwards to spot the spectacular peaks of the DOLOMITES. Stop in Cortina to enjoy the grand scenery. Later, cross over into Austria to reach Innsbruck in time to see the famous GOLDEN ROOF. (B)

## Day 9 – Thursday 30 August INNSBRUCK AREA – LIECHTENSTEIN – LUCERNE, SWITZERLAND

Drive through the valleys and villages of the mountainous Tyrol to the Arlberg Tunnel, descending into Switzerland. Stop briefly in Vaduz. Absorb the alpine scenery on the way to Lucerne. (B)

## Day 10 – Friday 31 August LUCERNE

Lucerne is nestled amid snow-capped Alps and surrounded by its lake. Orientation includes the LION MONUMENT, erected in memory of the 800 Swiss Guards who defended Louis XVI and his wife. Also see the famous wooden CHAPEL BRIDGE. (B, D)

## Day 11 – Saturday 01 September LUCERNE – PARIS, FRANCE

Cross into France and drive past some of its most famous Burgundy vineyards to Paris. (B)

## Day 12 – Sunday 02 September PARIS

This morning, see Paris' iconic landmarks during the included city tour. View the famous Arc de Triomphe, Opera, Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysees, and much more with a Local Guide. (B)

## Day 13 – Monday 03 September PARIS – MONT ST. MICHEL – ST. MALO

Travel towards the unique beauty of Mont St. Michel. This 8th-century abbey is a UNESCO World Heritage Site that creates an inspiring scene as it stands sentry on a small island just a kilometre off the French coast. (B)

## Day 14 – Tuesday 04 September ST. MALO - BREST

This morning, visit the ancient walled city of St. Malo. Spend some free time walking along its cobblestone streets and admiring the granite mansions, encircled by massive ramparts. Travel across Brittany to Brest. Heavily bombed in 1944, the city centre was rebuilt after the war. See the Pont de l'Iroise, a cable-stayed bridge spanning the Elorn River-an amazing architectural feat. (B, D)

## Day 15 – Wednesday 05 September BREST – CARNAC - NANTES

Follow the coastal road towards Carnac, known for its STANDING STONES that were erected by the pre-Celtic people of Brittany. Visit one of the sites with a Local Guide and learn about the mystery of the Carnac stones. Then, head for Nantes. Visit the CASTLE of the Dukes of Brittany, and the CATHEDRAL of St. Peter and St. Paul. (B)

## Day 16 – Thursday 06 September NANTES – LA ROCHELLE – ROCHEFORT – BORDEAUX

Stop at picturesque La Rochelle, known as La Ville Blanche (the White City) due to its luminous limestone facades that reflect the bright sunlight. Next up, Rochefort with its naval beginnings that date back to Louis XIV. Continue to Bordeaux. (B, D)

## Day 17 – Friday 07 September BORDEAUX

Bordeaux is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, home to 362 historic monuments, some dating back to Roman times. Join your Local Guide for a walking tour featuring all the important highlights. The afternoon is at leisure or join an optional excursion. (B)

## Day 18 – Saturday 08 September BORDEAUX – DUNE DU PILAT – LES LANDES - BIARRITZ

Drive to Arcachon today to see the amazing DUNE OF PILAT, the highest sand dune on the continent. Then, sit back and enjoy a scenic drive before arriving in Biarritz. (B)

## Day 19 – Sunday 09 September BIARRITZ – SAN SEBASTIAN, SPAIN – BILBAO - SANTANDER

Cross into Spain's Basque Country to visit San Sebastian! On to Bilbao, where you'll discover a colourful tapestry of architecture, history, and cuisine. Enjoy some free time. Later, head to Santander. (B)

## Day 20 – Monday 10 September SANTANDER – BURGOS - SALAMANCA

Stop in Burgos, former capital of the unified Kingdom of Castile-Leon for five centuries. Visit the limestone CATHEDRAL of Santa Maria, dating back to the 13th century. Continue on to Salamanca. (B, D)

## Day 21 – Tuesday 11 September SALAMANCA – AVILA – SEGOVIA - MADRID

Journey to Avila with its medieval town walls and many towers. Join the guided walking tour of the MEDIEVAL WALLS. Next, arrive in Segovia. Visit its landmarks, Roman AQUEDUCT and CATHEDRAL before heading to Madrid. (B)

## Day 22 – Wednesday 12 September MADRID

Because Madrid is situated 664 metres above sea level, the Spanish rightly say it is the nearest thing to Heaven. This morning, enjoy the city's main highlights on the included guided sightseeing tour. (B, D)

## Day 23 – Thursday 13 September MADRID – HONG KONG

After breakfast this morning we transfer to the airport for our flight home. (B)

## Day 24 – Friday 14 September HONG KONG – AUCKLAND

In transit.
